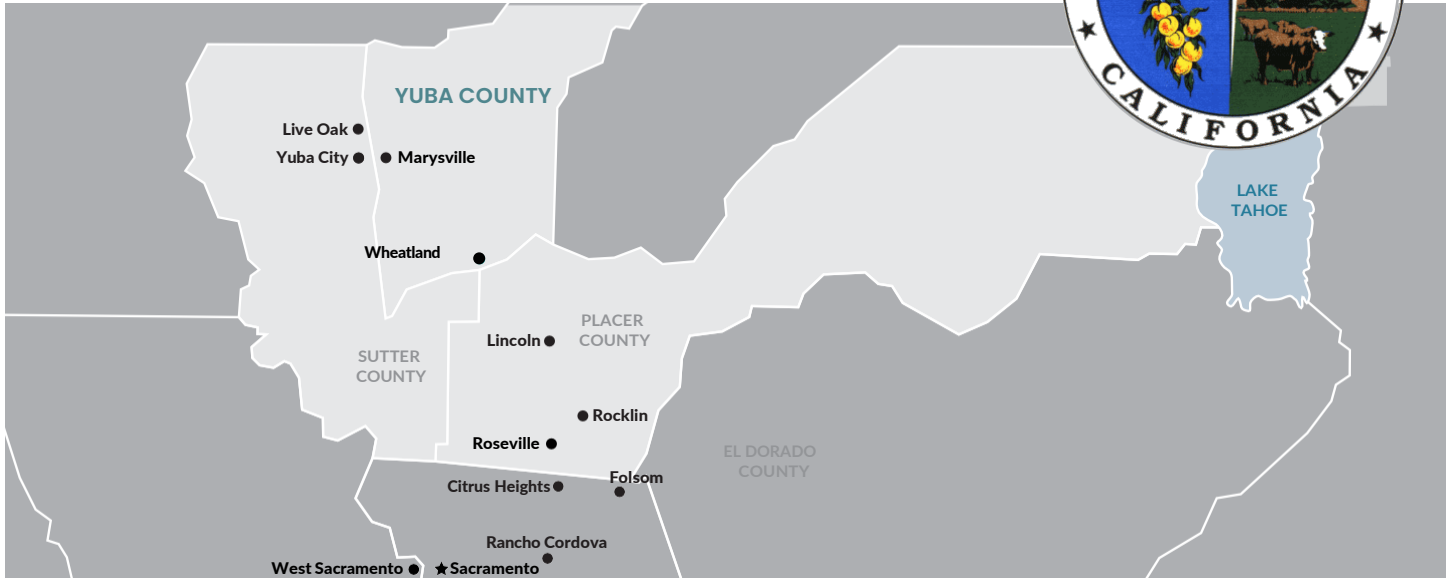


COMMUNITY PROFILE: Yuba County



Yuba County was one of the original counties of California, formed in 1850 at the time of statehood and is the gateway to the historic goldfields. With a population of nearly 80,000, residents enjoy relaxed living and affordable housing with mountain skiing and ocean beaches a few hours away. The County's most southern border is just 30 minutes north of the State Capital, Sacramento. Yuba County boasts fertile valley farming and higher-elevation camping, boating, fishing and historic mountain communities. Yuba County is home to Beale Air Force Base, the largest employer from Sacramento to the Oregon border. Recently, Hard Rock Hotel and Casino Sacramento located within its borders.
