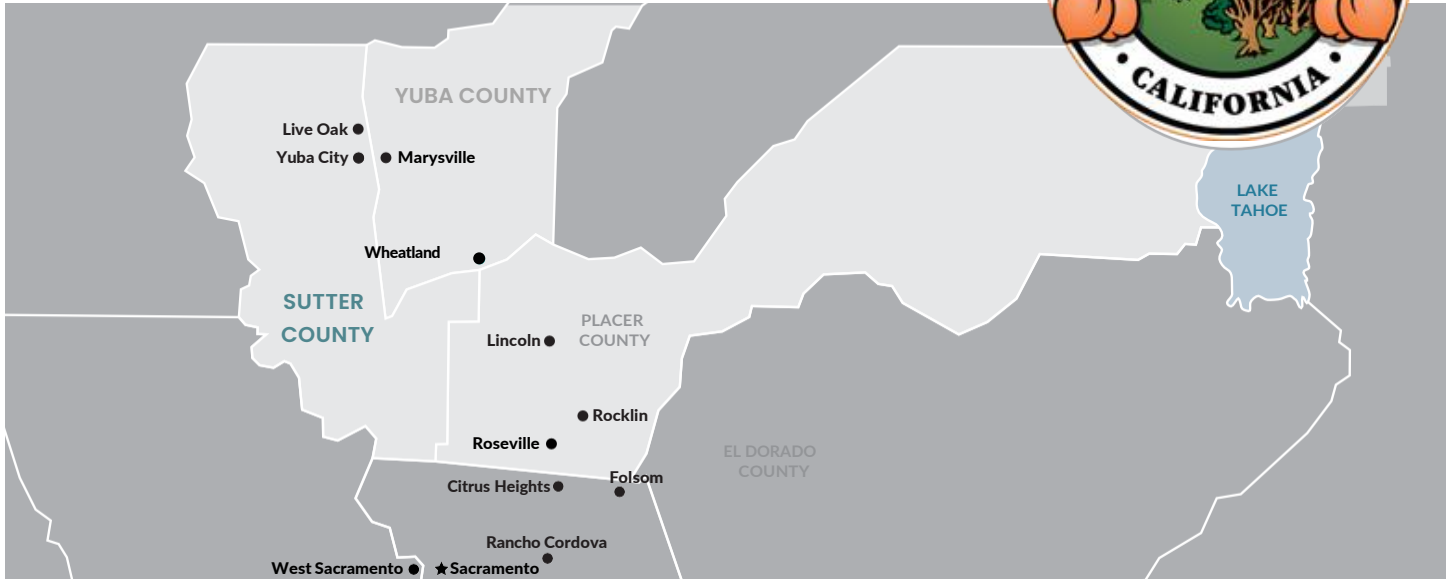


# COMMUNITY PROFILE: Sutter County
